Although many groups have an interest in the lake, there has historically been very little communication or coordination among those groups. The WWN aims to foster communication and collaboration on lake-related issues, and will be the only organization focusing exclusively on Lake Winnisquam and its watershed.

The group's initial efforts will include the development and implementation of a comprehensive water quality monitoring program for the lake, the prevention and control of milfoil and other invasive aquatic species, and **working with local municipalities to encourage and support planning on a watershed-wide basis**.
