All prints and associated documentation will be approved by the Sanbornton Fire Department and shall be kept at the building site at all times. All inspections on the system shall be conducted with reference to the approved prints and documentation. Failure to have the approved print on site during any inspections will prevent the system from signoff and approval.

Failure to have the print on site during any inspections will prevent the system from signoff and approval.
