

TOWN OF SANBORNTON

The following articles were adopted by the Town of Sanbornton at Town Meeting on March 6, 1973, and thereby became ordinances:

Article 27, Paragraph 2

“Curfew” No motorized off highway recreational vehicles shall be operated within the Town of Sanbornton between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. Motorized off highway recreational vehicles includes, without being limited to: motorcycles, trail bikes, mini- bikes, scooters, mini-carts, snowmobiles, all terrain vehicles, excepting law enforcement and emergency vehicles and their operators in performance of their duties

The operator, or operator’s legal guardian, if minor child, shall be fined twenty five dollars if found in violation of this ordinance.

Article 27, Paragraph 3

Restriction on Use: No motorized off highway recreational vehicles shall be operated within the Town of Sanbornton on the land of another without the express permission of the land-owner. Motorized Recreational Vehicles includes but is not limited to the following: motorcycles, trail bikes, mini- bikes, scooters, mini-carts, snowmobiles, all terrain vehicles, trail buggies and 4-wheel drive vehicles, excepting law enforcement and emergency vehicles and their operators in performance of their duties

The operator, or operator’s legal guardian, if minor child, shall be fined twenty five dollars if found in violation of this ordinance.
