Franz will take applications and suggested Nina take on Minutes. He will review the filing cabinets at the Town Office to determine what other topics remain for Sam and Barbara to organize.
 - Franz noted that he has not heard from the NH Division of Historic Resources for some time and they did not request the usual annual report last September.

VI. New or Other Business as brought forth by members.

• Sam Swartz has submitted an application to reconstruct the porch/deck on the south side of his home. The application was submitted so close to the meeting date that abutters could not be properly notified. It was decided to meet again in March to act on the application.
