Other Business: Rebekka will be taking a class in Quickbooks and using funds from the budget for bookkeeping support. Front door may need replacing. David will look at options. Motion was made to close the library when schools are closed due to weather. She and the assistant can work from home when needed during closings, MGray/GOImstead, unanimous.
