Before & After Care:

Elliott reports no changes. The program is looking into hiring new staff to work summer day camp.

Basketball:

There was talk about how next year coaches will need to sign a form during a coaches meeting prior to the season starting. The form will include equal playing time, scheduling practice times, and issuing of equipment. The Commission also spoke about if there are multiple coaches willing to coach that it is a good idea to give others a chance who have coached for previous years.

Also next year for the round robin that Sanbornton Rec hosts along with the Pines CC, raising admission to \$3 and teams who want to join to \$20 per team to help offset the costs of officials.
