**Meeting Minutes**: A motion was made by Olmstead and seconded by Seavey to accept the meeting minutes for the August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Recreation Commission monthly meeting with corrections. There was no meeting in September due to lack of quorum.

**Financials:** The committee reviewed the expenses and revenue for July, August and September. Pelissier noted that interest and childcare are not yet accounted for in the September financials. A motion was made by Seavey and seconded by Olmstead to approve the financials as presented.

**Revolving Fund**: A motion by Riendeau and seconded by Seavey to approve \$3,010.00 from the Revolving Fund for recreational activities (\$110.00 Pickleball Paddles; \$1,150.00 for basketball jerseys, med kits, scorebooks and supplies; \$1,000.00 for basketball officials, \$750 for the Christmas Social).

**Vote: Affirmative-Unanimous.** 

**Budget**: A first draft of the budget for the upcoming year was reviewed. Hiring Lifeguards again was discussed. There has been an ongoing issue with keeping the needed number of lifeguards at each beach. It was decided to post the beaches as "swim at your own risk". More beach cleaners are also needed. Ropes and buoys for the beaches, as well as large soccer nets are also included in the budget.

**Before & After School:** Elliot stated that she is looking for one more staff member to help with the increased number of children in the program. The doorbell is not working most of the time so parents are now needing to call the program to alert staff members they are waiting to be let in to the building.

**Fall Field Hockey**: Upcoming Jamboree the weekend of October 19<sup>th</sup>.

**Adult Co-Ed Pickle Ball:** Lonergan stated the program is still going well.

Adult Co-Ed Volleyball: Good turn out. Being held Mondays 7-9pm in the SCS gym.

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**Annual Halloween Party:** This year's party is scheduled for Saturday, October 26<sup>th</sup> 3-5pm at SCS. Fortune Teller returning this year. Candy being purchased this week.
