The flashlight egg hunt had some very poor weather conditions but Pelissier reached out the families who signed up and had them drive around back of the school so children could jump out and gather eggs, then jump back in their vehicles to lessen the chance of them getting soaked. About 35 children showed up for the flashlight egg hunt amongst the rain.

Sanbornton Central School 5K & Recreation Collaboration:

Pelissier said final deposit has been paid and the dunk tank is all set to be delivered to the school on Friday the 20th

Swim Lessons:

There will be four weeks of swim lessons this year, two of which are already full.

Town Park Sub-Committee:

Pelissier explained about the SLURF money that has been granted to the town of Sanbornton and what that means. The BoS would like to make sure that the building plans given to the town from 2016 still meet the needs of the town now. Pelissier informed the commission that she is working on writing a NH Parks grant to be submitted for March 2023. This grant, if approved, can be used towards anything recreation EXCEPT a building. Pelissier would like to focus on a small storage building with an accessible bathroom and an option to build on in the future.
