No bills larger than \$20 accepted

Rules:

- Speed limit 5mph
- Only courteous and respectful behavior will be tolerated
- No Solicitation per order of the Board of Selectman
- No commercial use without written approval from Board of Selectman
- No unattended children
- Pets must always remain in vehicles
- No smoking
- No private financial transactions of any kind are allowed
- Accepting limited hazardous waste. Household Hazardous Waste Day dates are posted at the Transfer Station

Household Trash (Municipal Solid Waste)

• Leaf or yard waste

- Wet-cell, rechargeable, lithium batteries
- Items with batteries still in them
- Construction or demolition debris (bulky items)
 - Large plastic items (tote bin, shoe rack, etc.)
 - \circ Furniture
 - \circ Small appliances
- Electronics
- Mercury containing devices
 - o Fluorescent light bulbs
 - \circ Thermostats
 - o Thermometers
 - Button cell batteries
- Large metal items

Pay-as-you-Throw

Stickers for your own bags	Sanbornton bags
Blue (33 gallons) = \$1.75	Large (33 gallons) = \$2.00
Pink (20 gallon) = \$1.50	Small (20 gallon) = \$1.75
Sold in sheets of 5 or individually	Sold in rolls of 10 or individually

Single Stream Recycling (Zero-Sort) Accepted Items:

- Clean plastics #1-#7
 - If there is no number that means it is not recyclable
- Clean food and beverage glass
- Clean cans: Aluminum, Tin, Steel
- Clean and dry paper: Magazines, junk mail, newspaper, etc.
- Clean and dry cardboard

Unaccepted items:

- Items that have not been cleaned. Wash your containers out!
- Food or food residue
- Greasy Cardboard (pizza boxes, to-go containers, etc.)
- Plastic bags or plastic wrap
- Styrofoam
- Toys & clothing
- Hazardous material
- Batteries (all kinds)
- Ceramics or baking glass
- Plant containers (pots, trays, etc.)
- Corrugated plastic
- Shredded paper
- Propane tanks

When in doubt, ask an Attendant. We are here to help!

Other Recycled Materials

Please see Attendant for these items

- Clean waste oil (each accepted oil can be mixed)
 - o Motor oil
 - Transmission oil
 - Hydraulic oil
 - $\circ~$ NO antifreeze, that is hazardous waste
 - NO water mixed oil
 - \circ NO cooking oils
 - Any containers brought in will not be returned
 - o 20 Quart maximum per week, per Resident/household
 - o Cannot be brought in a 5-gallon bucket
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Batteries
 - Lithium
 - \circ Rechargeable
 - o Button
- Electronics (charges apply)
 - $\circ~$ See price list for list of items and charges
- Tires (charges apply)
 - See price list for charges

Swap Shop

Open during Transfer Station operating hours

Accepted items:

- Clean, usable clothing
 - Must be in a bag and put in the clothing drop off bins
- Toys, games, puzzles
 - Must have all the pieces and not be broken
- Household items that are in GOOD condition
- Books
- Small furniture
 - Nightstand, dining chairs, step stool, etc.

Unaccepted items:

- Baby furniture
 - Cribs, bassinets, high chairs, stroller, changing table, etc.
- Safety items
 - Helmets, harnesses, protective sports gear, etc.
- Electric and electronic devices
 - o Items with cords
 - o Battery powered items, even if the batteries have been removed
 - Solar powered items
- Large furniture
 - Dining tables, dressers, entertainment centers, bookshelves, etc.
- Upholstered items
 - Couches, chairs, futons, foot rest, vehicle seats, etc.
- Mattresses and pillows

Construction & Demolition / Bulky Items <u>Rules:</u>

- No hazardous waste
- Must see an attendant before dumping anything

Other Commodities

Accepted items with charges:

- Freon items
 - o Fridge
 - o Freezer
 - o Air conditioner
 - o Dehumidifier
- Propane tanks
- Fire extinguishers

Accepted items with no charge:

- Brush
 - Less than 4 inches diameter
 - No longer than 6 feet long
- Compost
 - o Grass
 - o Leaves
- Scrap metal
